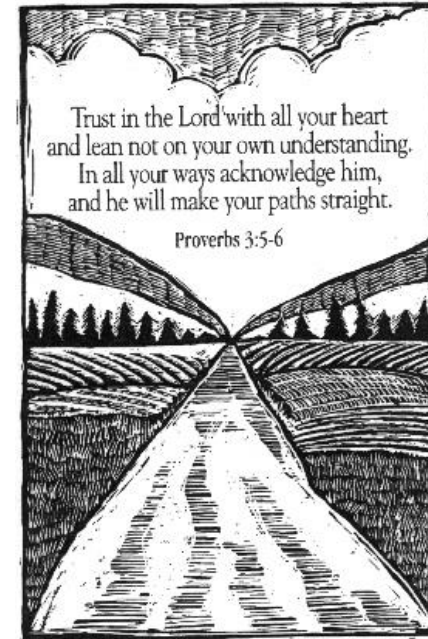

Morning Sermon: *The Frustrated Preacher* (Hab. 1:1-4)

Sometimes preachers get frustrated -not necessarily with other people - sometimes the frustration is with God. As God's spokesman, preachers want to see results; God often sees ministry. (This sermon is based upon the first 11 verses.)

Evening Lesson: *Go Show Your Story* (Matt. 8:1-4)

Jesus heals a leper. Great! Jesus doesn't just heal a leper; he touches a leper then heals him. But after healing, Jesus tells him, "See that you say nothing to anyone." The lesson for tonight is the rest of the sentence.

Sunday: *The Fisherman* (Hab. 1:14-17)

The frustrated preacher has a second complaint with God. He first states that God is sovereign, but then argues that sovereignty isn't fair. Ever complained to God that, even though He is God, he shouldn't do certain things?
