Morning Sermon: *The God I Have Heard Of* (Hab. 3:2-3)

Is your love for God based more upon what He has done for you or for who He is? I am thankful for all that God has done in and for me; my salvation tops that list. In this lesson, let's consider both what God does and who God is.

Evening Lesson: *Go to Whom?* (Luke 14:12-24)

We believe that there are still souls in this area that are not in a saving relationship with God through Jesus Christ. That fact alone should push us, who believe we are saved, to go and compel others to come.

Sunday: *"Yet" Faith* (Hab. 3:17-19)

Learning to trust God in spite of circumstances is how Habakkuk ends his prayerful song. God has not abandoned us; in fact, God is closer than we often "feel." The type of faith many of us need is a "yet" faith.
