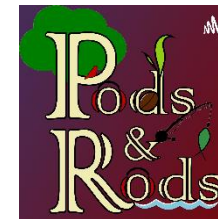


Ladies Class: Ladies' class will meet on Thursday evening at 7:30. Let Jane Hatfield know if you would like the link for this Zoom class.
